Evan Currie is one of the few authors I'll buy books from on name alone. I wasn't disappointed here. I will say this book took me a little longer to get hooked than others he's done, but after about a third of the way in the story started picking up. I think that has more to do with my indifference to the setting than anything on Evan's part, but once I got into the setting the story took hold and was quite enjoyable. By the end I was really glad that this was book 1 of a new series and eagerly await the rest.

I found *The Knighthood* to be another great story by Evan Currie. His story arcs are always refreshing and original. He has developed stories and worlds that are detailed, new, and intriguing. I am usually not a fan of "demon" stories, but as the story progressed and the background information was revealed, I was more comfortable with the concept. Of course there is a lot more information that is awaiting in future installments. *Knighthood* starts a bit slow but builds to a satisfactory conclusion. As with most of Evan's stories there is always another chapter that is ready to unfold. I have found that his character development is quite satisfying and I am always amazed at how his protagonists are usually strong female characters. *Knighthood* is no exception. I am ready for the next chapter.

My only disappointment about the book is that there isn't a sequel yet! I agree with others that this is one of Evan Currie's best books, with a fascinating new protagonist and strong supporting characters.

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
