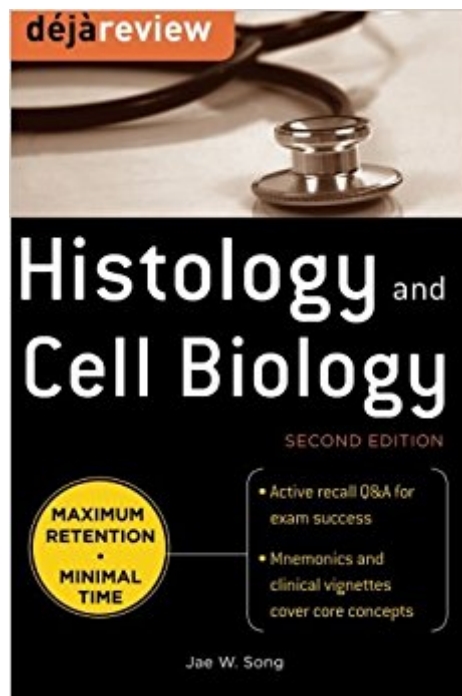

This book was helpful for reviewing general concepts, but histology is such a visual science that it was not great for reviewing for tests.

Good for reviewing and memorizing key facts. It has only a few pictures, so not really helpful in the visual aspect of histology. But if you need to memorize particular facts and definitions for class or boards, this is a good book. Not really good for understanding the big concepts, but your textbook is for that. It is a question and answer format, so you use active recall when you study. Active recall is proven to be a very effective study method.
