This is a great start to a fantasy series: witches and wizards, pirates and dragons. It reminds me of the fantasy films of my childhood, such as The Neverending Story and the Princess Bride. In a world on the brink of war, two groups are unwittingly caught in the midst of upheaval. Raven steals an

illegal magic little knowing that an evil wizard is searching for it. Together with her friend, Sim, Raven is being held hostage by a powerful witch with secrets of her own. On the other side: John harbors a family secret that haunts him. He has no memory of what happened in his past, but he's been running from it since he was a child and trying to find answers. Wary of being dragged into a war with wizards, the pirate collides with a witch - a witch wanted by the Dark Wizard. As the two groups' storylines converge, they realize they can help each other and not just in terms of saving their lives, but working out who they are. All in all, this was a great romp of a read and I'm looking forward to the next one. If you like fantasy, I recommend you pick this one up now and it could be read by people of all ages.

The story began in a not so distant past where a dark witch & wizard set their sights on a young girl with ancient powers hidden away from the magical world. So arrogant and sure of their success, they didn't take into consideration the young girl's brother and his bravery and lover for his sister. Together, the young ones fought them with disastrous consequences. Fast forward a few years, Raven is now a young woman with a hazy memory of that night believing that she was somehow responsible for the death of her loved-ones and that the dark witch took her under her wings making her forever in her debt for her very existence. She has no idea of the powers that ran in veins which Esme managed to hide from herself as well as the rest of the world. Believing herself to be human, Raven served Esme like a slave along with her friend Sim as she followed every bidding demanded from her while silently hoping that one day she would be free. Across the sea from her, another story unfolds involving a dashing pirate who came across a runaway witch. John kept a heart-breaking secret in his past under lock and key away from even his closest friends choosing to sail away into the welcoming waves of the sea. Until a witch stowed away in his ship and stole his heart. Fate eventually intervened causing their paths to cross resulting to a magical adventure featuring a dragon, falling stars, colliding hearts and an epic battle between wizards and witches. Honestly, I wasn't entirely sure if I would love this story as much as the other books from Ms Keys because there just wasn't enough blood and gore in this one which I've attached to her books. But this author created such a beautiful and colourful world rivalling the Pirates of the Caribbean that I couldn't help but be snared into the magical web leaping out from each pages I read. Would I recommend this book? Hell, yes! You would not be disappointed.
