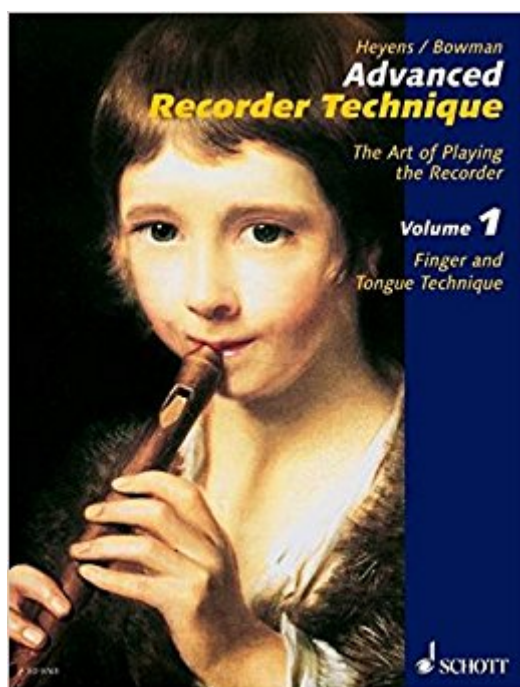

This book is helpful to an extent, mainly for scales in all keys. However, some of the technique is not explained well at all, for instance, the finger vibrato. I give it 3 stars for this reason. Would I order this book again? Probably not.

This book is very detailed and filled with scales and explanation of technique. However, beware, it is

written in the Key of 'F' so if you have learned on a recorder in the Key of 'C' which most basic recorders are keyed to, this book will probably not be for you. If you are accustomed to playing an 'F' recorder, then this book is certainly a very well written and helpful book.
