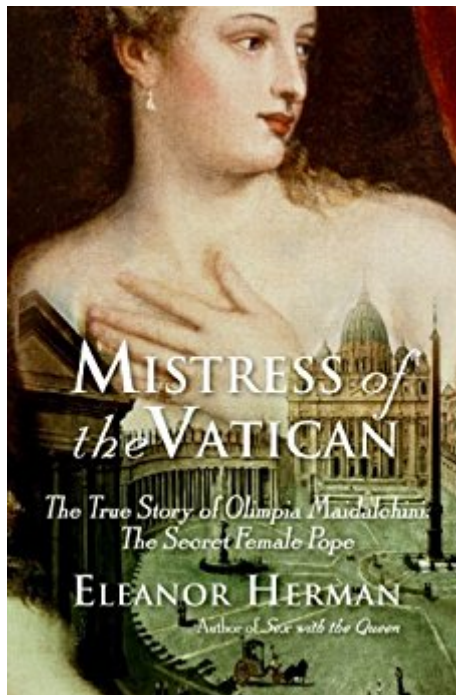




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Mistress Of The Vatican: The True Story Of Olimpia Maidalchini: The Secret Female Pope

I love history and a few years ago visited the two palaces in Rome where Olimpia called home. However, I never expected this to be such compelling reading. Ms. Herman's exhaustive research is illuminating rather than pedantic. You will learn a great deal about Ms. Mldalchini, the Byzantine politics of the Vatican and the complicated power plays in Europe. Olympia was a remarkable woman by any definition but quite extraordinary when one considers the chauvinistic attitudes of Baroque Europe. This book makes history come alive and is well with the reader's time.
