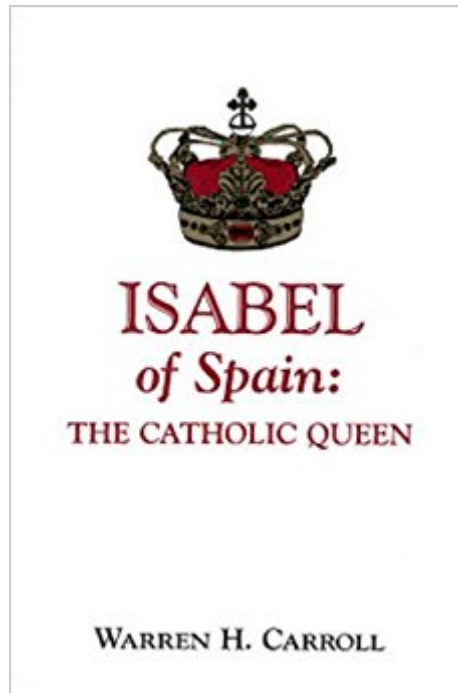




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Isabel Of Spain: The Catholic Queen

Author is clearly pro-Isabel and glosses over some of her shortcomings, but it is well-researched and well-written.

Well researched. A panegyric to be sure but detractors will find Carroll is honest about her failures and offers strong arguments in defense of her controversial actions, especially regarding the Spanish Inquisition. This should be required reading for adolescent girls as Isabel is a compelling model of strong feminine leadership. Would give 5 stars but for a number of typos.

I want to counter the reviewer of this book who was so angered by it. I found this book to be in agreement with other historians who look at Isabel in the light of her times without modern prejudices and preconceptions. She was an exceptionally great historical figure; this book tells you why. It will help you to understand Isabel's world and how she took a corrupt and chaotic state and ushered it into a golden age. Another great biography of Isabel is William Thomas Walsh's "The Last Crusader, Isabella of Spain" published in 1930. I recommend reading both biographies.

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
