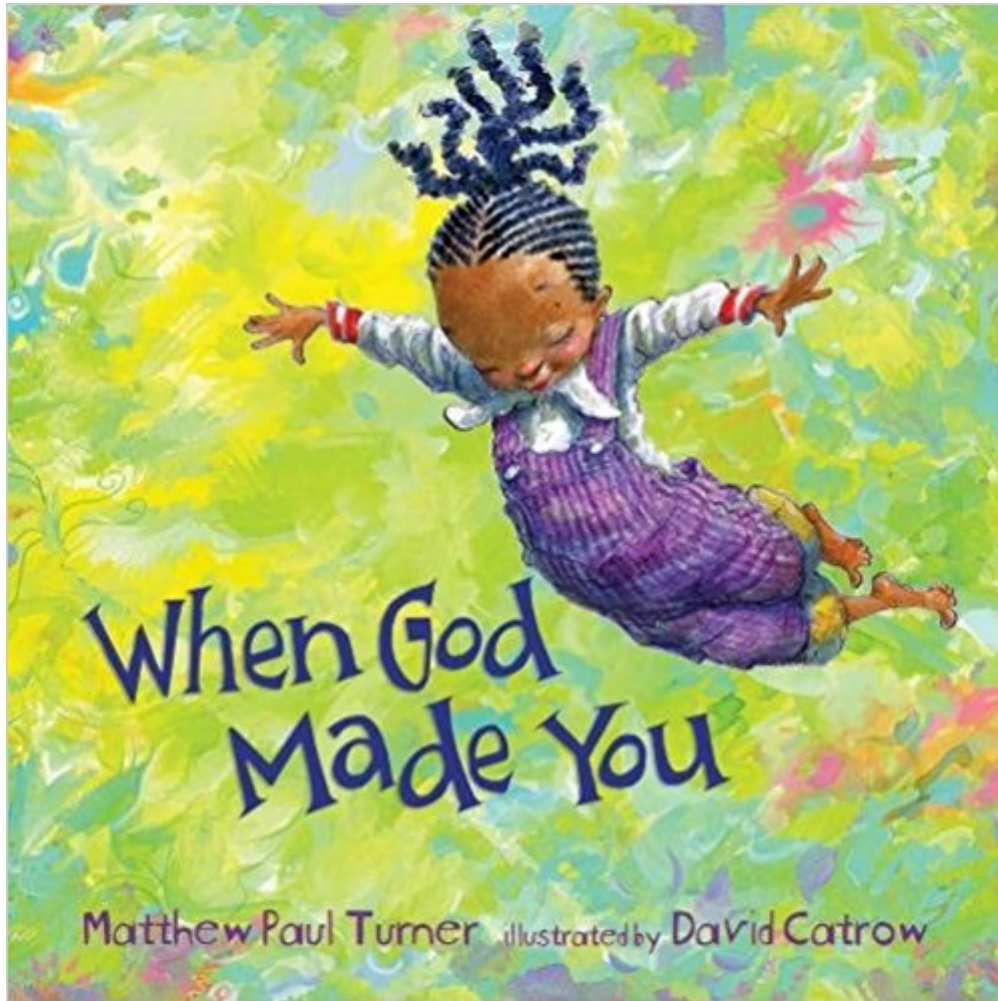

But Matthew Paul Turner actually has a talent for it and I hope he keeps at it. My 4-year old loves the rhyme and the illustrations and he asks a lot of questions while we read it. And he requests to read it again and again which is rare with the Christian books that I buy for him. I like the story for clearly showing how we are made in the image of God and that he is pleased and delighted by us. Those who are asking for more theological precision beyond that are really splitting hairs in ways that young children can't appreciate. If you are stressed about it I'm sure you can teach your preschooler the Westminster Shorter Catechism. I also love that the heroine of the book is a black little girl who is independent, creative, and compassionate. I look for diversity in the books that we buy and this one is perfect!

This is a beautiful book that is full of beautiful ideas about our intersections with the divine. It is not for the fundamentalist at heart, and I love it for that. Self-worth is an ideal that we should be instilling in our kids from the day that they're born until the day we part, and religion should never get in the way of that. LOVE!
