Saving Angel is the first book in a 5 book series, 7 books total with the novella side stories as well. Angel Morgan, girl geekiness who loves and choose her free time to play Xbox games. Her and her mom moves from Arizona to a whole in the wall town of Spring Valley, Illinois. Things get interesting when she meets their neighbors, three teenagers about her age, neighbors that will bring an underworld of trouble. Chase Winters and his cousins Lexi and Travis are Divisa-half demon, half human with supernatural powers and glowing eyes. If you have read J. Armentrout's Lux series, then you will have already an idea of how this series goes. You just basically replace aliens to half demons. I felt like I was reading the same story. I am not saying that to hurt the author but this could of had so much potential. I loved the geekiness and hot banter between the characters and was very humorous at times. I am still going to read the rest of the series to find out the outcome of the ending.

Yes this book went in a totally different direction and finally moved away from its Lux similarities. I love the relation ship between Chase and Angel even though i still want to slap him most of the time. Its cute. I think Angel commented on how hot chase was a little too much for my liking but i can move on from this :)

I'm not a 100% sure because she is hardly a part of the story (aside from her couple and her cooking). And really ? What kind of parent is that dumb ? 2. Lexi is Angel's best friend. So Angel says. Curious, because I am pretty sure Lexi went from being a regular member of the cast to a mere recurring. Too bad, she was kick ass ! 3. Emma. Her character is uninteresting. Her banter is similar to Angel's. And the mood swings. She has issues. The thing is : what issues ? Cause I sure as hell don't want to pay 5 to discover it by reading a novella. At least, in Jennifer Estep's Mythos Academy, you don't feel cheated by not buying novellas. I still liked it. I read it in a day. *hooked !*

Can I say awesome sequel? "Hunting Angel" was absolutely fabulous and didn't disappoint me in the least! I loved loved loved reading more about Chase and Angel. Their hot and cold relationship is addictive and freaking entertaining as heck. Yes, I love it when it's hot, but I enjoy the cold just as

Although these books are copies of the Lux series, I was willing to continue reading after reading the first book. But I became fed up with the childishness that is Angel, and the return of Emma was the last straw for me. My advice is to please read the Lux series by Jennifer L. Armentrout. They are well worth your time and the money. The novels are better written and leaves you on the edge of your seat breathless. This author should really be ashamed of herself for copying every inch of those books. Well, she did change the names of the characters and made them half-demons instead of aliens.
