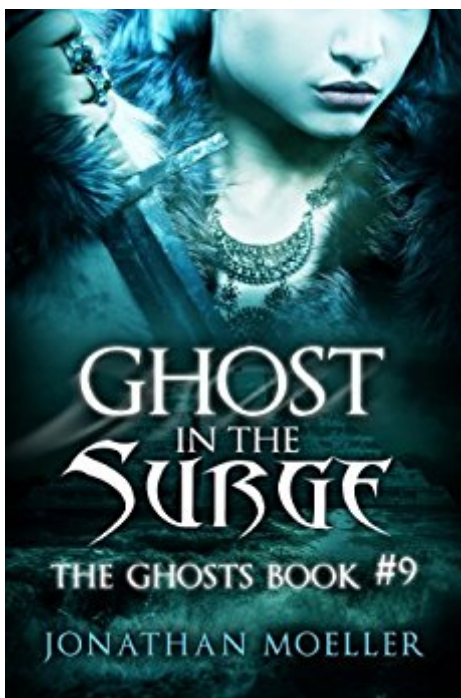

To be honest at this point I was not sure who I was rooting for more the Moroaica or Caina, a testament to how well the characters were designed and fleshed out across the series. The book is a fitting closing to the story arc, the final showdown in prime form. Moroaica's grand design is great, Caina's uphill battle equally so. This book shakes up the series status quo like a good finale should. Also, would give 6th star for the new revolutionary treatment for magical amnesia - sledgehammer to the head!

The Moracacia is about to complete her great work. Unfortunately her twisted mind doesn't realise that it will destroy the world. Caina has one chance to stop the destruction. She is being hunted as a criminal though and even if her friends help her she may lose everything she holds dear.

This was a satisfying, awesome conclusion not so much to the series (as the next Caina book will be coming out in the Spring of 2014), but to the long progressing Jadriga arc which started 4 books ago and has been simmering in the background during Caina's other adventures. Caina faces her most difficult challenges yet as all the good she's done over her years of service to the Empire is questioned. The writing in this series, and especially through the climax with this book, is much darker than the author's other series that I enjoyed (Demonsoiled), and gave it a real gritty, realistic atmosphere to the tragedies that arose. One thing I noticed was there was not as much of her deducing conclusions as with the previous books, but that is in most part due to it being a non-stop thrill ride from beginning to end - seriously, no caravan rides across new lands, or new characters to introduce with shining backstories, but action-scene after action-scene, with a good use of imagery and descriptions (golden army, phobomorphic amulet illusions, the workings of Jadriga's great work). Can't wait to read the continuation of Caina's adventures with the next book Ghost in the Cowl, and what the riddle at the end of this book meant for it.

Over half the book had missing pages, 2 to 3 at a time. Read one page, skip 3, read another page, skip 3. Book was 75% repetitive of all others in this series. Really not worth my time nor money. Extremely frustrating. Will not be buying the next book, a chapter of which is included at the end.

Loved the series! I am a huge fan of Jonathan Moeller's writing style. I really enjoy the way he builds characters. Over time, you end up getting very attached to them. I also appreciate the depth in the stories and that there are often many in a series so there's no need to suffer separation anxiety :-)

Not a bad way to go out of the main series. It was a struggle along the way with many of the books in dire need of a skilled editor and grammar checker, but here was stand at the end. My feeling of this book is that it is good - not great, but still a solid good. My feeling of the series is a bit more roller coaster. Many of the books in the middle were pretty much so formulaic that it felt like reading the same Grisham novel over and over again. It had the sense of running the plot through a copy machine and then just changing the names and places to protect the innocent. Still, for the cost you can do far worst in this genre.

Will Caina ever get her happily ever after? This book was painful to read at several points. I have gotten really attached to the characters in this series and it is hard to see them going through hard things. I was hoping she would eventually be able to just have some time to enjoy her life. This book left me feeling heartbroken otherwise I would have given it 5 stars. I love Moeller and his writing and despite the way I felt at the end of this book I will continue to read and have faith. I really hope he has a happily ever after in him for Caina eventually. *hope hope!*
