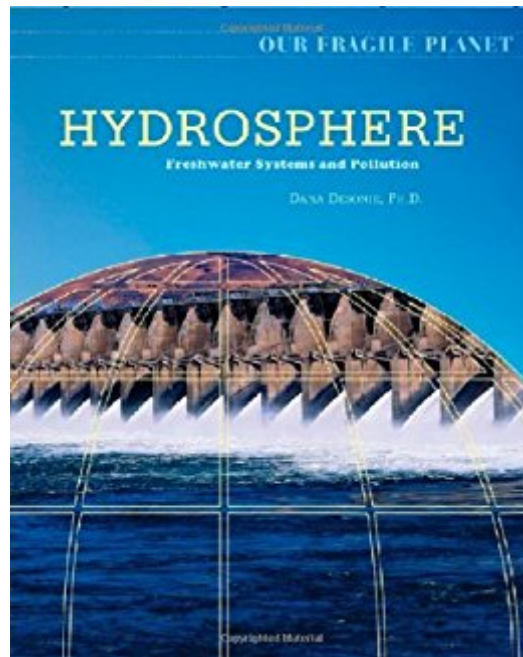

Readers will find information about the water cycle, surface waters, surface water resources, and ground water and its use. Part two looks at pollutants that are introduced into fresh water, and part three traces the history of pollution in the Great Lakes. It also discusses clean-up options. Excellent background material is provided on each topic. This thought-provoking book will make children and adults view our fragile planet in a new way. Written for students in grades 6 through 12, it could also be read by some elementary students. It would also be an excellent reference book for teachers.
